







EURES: Fair Work Anywhere in Europe

Free movement of workers is one of the four freedoms enjoyed by EU citizens.

This includes:

- > the rights of movement and residence for workers
- > the rights of entry and residence for family members
- > the right to work in another Member State
- the right to be treated on an equal footing with nationals of that Member State.

The EU supports your right of free movement by offering services through the EURES network.

EURES is a European cooperation network of employment services. It covers all European Union countries as well as Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland. EURES staff supports and consults you regarding finding a job, living, working and hiring EU-wide and in cross-border regions.


















EURES services to jobseekers and employers include:

- > Matching of job vacancies and CVs on the EURES portal
- ➤ Information and guidance and other support services for workers and employers
- ➤ Access to information on living and working conditions in the EU member states, such as taxation, pensions, health insurance and social security
- Specific support services for frontier workers and employers in cross-border regions
- Support to specific groups in the context of the EURES Targeted Mobility Schemes
- Support to dynamic recruitment events through the European (Online) Job Days platform
- ➤ Information on and access to post-recruitment assistance, such as language training and support with integration in the destination country
